University ROTC Relations Committee Summary Report 2010-2011 Academic Year

The only activities of the URRC for the 2010-2011 Academic Year were to meet for purposes of interviewing and approving proposed new faculty for the 3 ROTC branches as needs arose. A total of one meeting was held, on 8 Feb. 2010. The committee interviewed a total of 1 candidate, who was a candidate to teach for the Navy detachment.
