

**CAPP Report to the Faculty Senate Concerning AAP**  
**January 2003**

Just before Christmas Provost Martin and Vice Provost Cohen met with the members of the Faculty of the College of Architecture, Art, and Planning to respond to the AAP Realignment Committee report of Dec. 3. At that meeting the Provost announced that the College of Architecture, Art, and Planning would not be disbanded nor would specific departments be dissolved nor made into independent Schools. However, there will be a faculty committee appointed, with faculty from both inside and outside the College, charged with developing a strategic intellectual plan for the College. There will also be a faculty committee, also with members from both inside and outside the College, charged with developing proposals for shared curricular requirements and/or joint course offerings. This decision appears to remove the need for Senate action at this time.
