

Resolutions Concerning the Academic Calendar

1. *Whereas* orientation for new students in the fall semester will conclude on Tuesday,
Be it resolved that Classes start on the following Wednesday of the fall semester.

2. *Whereas* classes will start on Wednesday of the fall semester,
Be it resolved that the fall semester be lengthened by one day.

3. *Whereas* classes will start on Wednesday of the fall semester
Be it resolved that there be no classes on the Wednesday before Thanksgiving break

4. *Whereas* classes will start on Wednesday of the fall semester,
Be it resolved that there will be no classes on Labor Day.

Implications:

- It is assumed that the first resolution will pass.
- If the second resolution passes, then the third and fourth resolutions will not be considered and voting will cease. We will start fall classes on Wednesday and the fall semester will be lengthened by a day.
- If the second resolution is defeated we will vote on the third resolution. If the third resolution passes, then the fourth resolution will not be considered and voting will cease. The first day of fall classes will be on Wednesday, with no classes on Wednesday before Thanksgiving.
- If the third resolution is defeated, we will consider the fourth. If the fourth resolution passes, we will start fall classes on Wednesday and there will be no classes on Labor Day.

If the first resolution passes and all others are defeated, the fall semester will be lengthened by a day.
