

**PROCLAMATION TO HONOR
HER HIGHNESS SHEIKHA MOZAH BINT NASSER AL-MISSNED**

In grateful appreciation for her vision and commitment to education, the President, the Provost for Medical Affairs, and the Provost recommend that Cornell University issue a Proclamation on behalf of its governing boards, faculty and senior administration honoring **Her Highness Sheikha Mozah Bint Nasser Al-Missned**.

Explanation: When history is written, it will no doubt single out Her Highness as a strong and vocal proponent for making medical education available to students around the world. Indeed, the establishment of Education City and Weill Cornell Medical College in Qatar, the first medical school in Qatar, is proof of her foresight and dedication to her country, the region and a world in need. Her Highness' commitment to education in the Middle East truly embodies the spirit of Ezra Cornell: "Any person ... any study;" and Weill Cornell's tripartite mission: education, research and patient care.

This resolution is subject to approval by the Board of Trustees, the Board of Overseers, the Faculty Senate, and the Weill Cornell General and Executive Faculty Councils. If approved by all bodies, the Proclamation will be presented to Her Highness during the ceremonies to be held in Qatar in early May celebrating the first graduating class of Weill Cornell Medical College in Qatar.
