STUDY PERIOD NEEDS TO BE EXTENDED NOT CUT SHORT. I don't know where the administration got the idea that it was long. Perhaps this applies students who mainly have papers due rather exams, but this does not apply to people like engineers or science majors where grades are heavily finals based.

Ending the semester any later than it already is would be unacceptable. It is already difficult enough to accommodate internships and summer plans with how late the current spring semester ends.

We have an abnormally long winter break (I only know one person who got back to school later than we did, a Brown student), and go far into May, with many of my friends at different schools ending exams by May 13th. The two breaks are important, but instead of pushing February break back a week, we should just start and end the semester a week earlier. February break would be relatively later this way. Also, it would make it plausible to push Spring break a week forward to a normal time. My family is going on vacation without me at the end of March because my dad's grad school and my sister's high school are on break but I am not. The shorter exam period though, good idea but not short enough. It's an improvement, though.
