<p>V. The Dean of the University Faculty</p> <p>F. Selection</p> <p>1. The Dean must be selected from among the tenured voting members of the Faculty and shall maintain such status.</p> <p>3. The Committee on Nominations and Elections shall conduct a mail ballot of the voting members of the University Faculty, using the Hare System, and shall promptly report the results to the President and the Faculty.</p>	<p>V. The Dean of the University Faculty</p> <p>F. Selection</p> <p>1. The Dean must be selected from the UF* and must maintain that status.</p> <p>3. The Committee on Nominations and Elections shall conduct a mail ballot of the members of the University and RTE Faculties who have university voting rights. The Hare System is to be used with results promptly reported to the President and all members of the electorate.</p>

Notes. By deleting “tenured” in paragraph 1 we are making it legal for an emeritus/a faculty member to serve as Dean of Faculty. The Emeriti are voting members of the University Faculty, but because they have retired, they do not have tenure status.
