- 1. The sustainability issue. To ensure longevity, programs have to be embedding in existing units that will always be around, e.g., departments and colleges.
- 2. The activism component. The outcome is policy, not protests. The goal is permanent change and that comes through policies that are adopted.
- 3. The mandatory idea. We should try to live off of existing courses and existing requirements. Students like choice.
- 4. The distribution of resources from the center to researchers and research groups should be an attribute of the center.
- 5. On the two educational requirements, there was an assertion that faculty are the bigger problem. This was challenged but it is clear that we expect more from faculty.
- 6. Criteria for getting menu. Can have a course on race which is not antiracist.
- 7. Module approach: can be superficial
